News from a foreign land: This month we have a very special story for you. At the beginning of the month our sister told us that our friend's father had cancer and was in the hospital. His name is Tawn. The doctors told them the cancer was very bad. Our sister took us to visit him in the hospital. The first time we went, Tawn was receiving chemo and was sleeping. Tawn turned 67 years old while receiving chemo. Folks started praying that God would open his heart. The next Monday, we went to visit Tawn. He was awake and sitting up.
